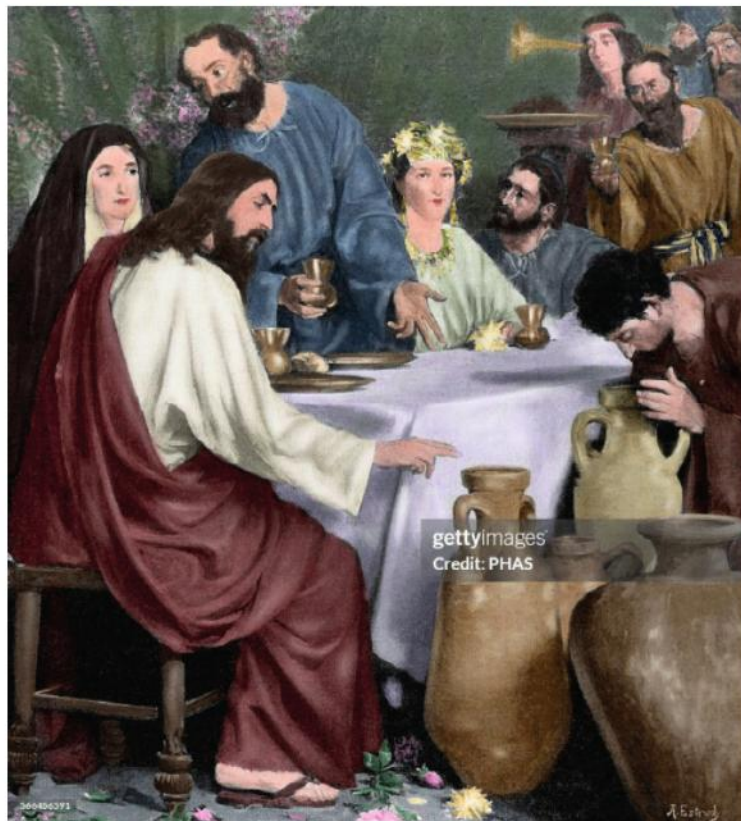

JUBILEE 2025 ~ PILGRIMS OF HOPE

What is a Jubilee? A Jubilee is a special year of prayer. Jubilees are times for forgiveness, reconciliation, and pilgrimage and are a part of the Catholic tradition. Jubilees ordinarily take place every twenty-five years.

When does this Jubilee begin? Pope Francis will formally open the Holy Doors at St. Peter's Basilica on December 24, 2024. Locally, our observance of the Jubilee will begin on December 29, 2024.

What is the theme of Jubilee 2025? The theme of Jubilee 2025 is Pilgrims of Hope. "Everyone knows what it is to hope. In the heart of each person, hope dwells as the desire and expectation of good things to come, despite our not knowing what the future may bring...For all of us, may the Jubilee be an opportunity to be renewed in hope." ~ Pope Francis

How can I celebrate the Jubilee locally? - A Pilgrimage Diocesan Retreat on March 31, April 1, & April 2 taking us to three different sites in the Diocese of Syracuse for a 2-hour evening of prayer and reflection each night. This event will also be livestreamed, and more details will be available after the New Year. - A Diocesan Pilgrimage to the National Shrine of Divine Mercy at Stockbridge, MA in Fall 2025
